1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, delete lines 14 through 27 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

3 (6) "Unemployment insurance" means the unemployment benefits payable under the state  
4 unemployment insurance law other than work-sharing and includes any amounts payable  
5 pursuant to an agreement under any federal law providing for compensation, assistance, or  
6 allowances with respect to unemployment.7 (7) "Usual weekly hours of work" means the usual hours of work for full-time or part-time  
8 employees in the affected unit when that unit is operating on its regular basis, not to exceed  
9 forty hours and not including hours of overtime work.10 (8) "Work-sharing benefits" means unemployment benefits payable to employees in an  
11 affected unit under an approved work-sharing plan, as distinguished from the unemployment  
12 benefits otherwise payable under the unemployment insurance provisions of this state.13 (9) "Work-sharing plan" means a plan submitted by an employer, for approval by the  
14 administrator, under which the employer requests the payment of work-sharing benefits to  
15 workers in an affected unit of the employer to avert layoffs.
