5 **"A.(1) On or before June 1, 2021, each cable service provider and video**  
6 **service provider shall prepare and submit to the commission an emergency**  
7 **service plan, which shall include a provider's emergency preparedness and**  
8 **response plan to an emergency or disaster.**

9 **(2) The emergency service plan shall include all of the following**  
10 **information:"**

27 **"B.(1) Upon receipt of an emergency service plan, the commission shall**  
28 **review the plan to determine compliance with the provisions of this Chapter and**  
29 **any rules and regulations of the commission.**

30 **(2) On or before August first of each year, the commission shall submit**  
31 **a written declaration certifying compliance or noncompliance with the**  
32 **provisions of this Section for each cable service provider and video service**  
33 **provider to the director of the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and**

1 Emergency Preparedness, the Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer  
2 Protection and International Affairs, and the House Committee on Commerce.

3 C. Each cable service provider and video service provider shall review  
4 its emergency service plan on an annual basis. If any change is made to the  
5 emergency service plan, the revised plan shall be submitted to the commission  
6 on or before the following June first. If no change was made to the emergency  
7 service plan, written notification that the previously submitted plan is current  
8 shall be submitted to the commission on or before the following June first.

9 D. On or before March 1, 2021, the commission shall adopt rules and  
10 regulations consistent with its rulemaking authority in Article 4, Section 21(B)  
11 of the Constitution of Louisiana to implement the provisions of this Chapter.

12 E. The filing of an emergency service plan in accordance with the  
13 provisions of this Section shall not subject any cable service provider or video  
14 service provider to any regulatory jurisdiction by the commission not in effect  
15 on December 1, 2020.

16 F. If a cable service provider or video service provider uses the same  
17 facilities to provide any other service regulated by the commission and files with  
18 the commission an emergency service plan for that service that includes an  
19 emergency preparedness and response plan for cable service, video service, or  
20 both, that cable service provider or video service provider shall not be required  
21 to submit an additional emergency service plan pursuant to the provisions of  
22 this Section."

25 "Section 2. This Act shall become effective on December 1, 2020."
