AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 27:309(A)(2), relative to fantasy sports; to provide for limitations; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 27:309(A)(2) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§309. Allowing certain players to play fantasy sports contests; penalties; revocation hearing

A. \* \* \*

(2) No person licensed pursuant to the provisions of this Chapter, or any agent or employee thereof, shall allow a person to ~~participate in~~ **enter into** a fantasy sports contest while located in a parish in which, at the election held pursuant to R.S. 27:303, a majority of the qualified electors in the parish voting on the proposition to authorize fantasy sports contests in the parish voted against the proposition.

\* \* \*

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If

1 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become  
2 effective on the day following such approval.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
