Fields

<u>Present law</u> requires that student assessments be conducted and student achievement and student growth data be used in evaluating teachers, schools, and school districts.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and additionally provides that notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, for the 2020-2021 school year, the results from student assessments shall not be used for student progression or teacher evaluations.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

(Amends R.S. 17:3997(D)(2); adds R.S. 17:24.4(F)(1)(i) and 3902(E))
