 thirty days from its effective date or shall cease on the date of earlier termination of
 the governor's declared emergency, but may be renewed by the commissioner to
- coincide with any extension thereof.
- 16 (4) The provisions of this Subsection apply when the declared state of emergency or public health emergency described in Paragraph (1) of this Subsection
- is actively occurring and impacting insureds in this state."
