2 On page 1, line 2, change "R.S. 29:776" to "R.S. 29:740 and 776"

4 On page 1, at the beginning of line 3, change "public health" to "certain"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 1, line 8, change "R.S. 29:776 is" to "R.S. 29:740 and 776 are"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 4

8 On page 1, between lines 8 and 9, insert the following:

9 "740. Religious assembly during emergencies

10 A. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, no natural or juridical person
 11 shall be liable for any civil damages, fines, or penalties for assembling to exercise
 12 religious freedom during an emergency.

13 B. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, no natural or juridical person
 14 shall be liable for criminal prosecution for assembling to exercise religious freedom
 15 during an emergency."

16 AMENDMENT NO. 5

17 On page 1, line 12, after "during a public" delete the remainder of the line and delete line 13
 18 in its entirety and insert "health emergency."

19 AMENDMENT NO. 6

20 On page 1, line 16, after "during a public" delete the remainder of the line and delete line 17
 21 in its entirety and insert "health emergency."
