
SENATE FLOOR AMENDMENTS

2020 Second Extraordinary Session

Amendments proposed by Senator Bernard to Engrossed Senate Bill No. 51 by Senator Barrow

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 Delete Senate Floor Amendment No.1 proposed by Senator Barrow and adopted by the
3 Senate on October 13, 2020, designated as SFASB51 CANNONB 520.

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 Delete the set of Senate Floor Amendments, proposed by Senator Barrow and adopted by
6 the Senate on October 13, 2020, designated as SFASB51 CANNONB 441.

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, line 2, after "To" delete the remainder of the line and on line 2 delete "paragraph
9 of 1218.1(A)" and insert "enact R.S. 37:1218.2"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 1, line 4, after "administration of" delete the remainder of the line, delete line 5, and
12 on line 6, delete "other immunizations and vaccines including"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 5

14 On page 1, delete lines 10 through 17 and on page 2, delete lines 1 through 15, and insert the
15 following:

16 "Section 1. R.S. 37:1218.2 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

17 **§1218.2. Administration of COVID-19 vaccine**

18 **A. A pharmacist may administer a COVID-19 vaccine to any**
19 **person three years of age or older without a prescription or medical**
20 **order contingent upon all of the following provisions:**

21 **(1) The pharmacist shall administer the COVID-19 vaccine in**
22 **conformance with the most current immunization administration**
23 **protocol as set forth by the United States Centers for Disease Control**
24 **and Prevention Advisory Committee on Immunization Practice.**

25 **(2) The pharmacist shall report each COVID-19 vaccination to**
26 **the Louisiana Department of Health, office of public health's Louisiana**
27 **Immunization Network for Kids Statewide at the time of the**
28 **immunization or as soon as reasonably practicable thereafter.**

29 **(3) The pharmacist shall report all adverse events he observes or**
30 **which are reported to him to the Vaccine Adverse Events Reporting**
31 **System, the cooperative program of the United States Centers for**
32 **Disease Control and Prevention and the United States Food and Drug**
33 **Administration for vaccine safety, or its successor program. The**
34 **pharmacist shall also refer the patient with an adverse event to the**
35 **COVID-19 vaccination for appropriate medical care.**

36 **(4) The pharmacist shall maintain for at least two years a record**
37 **of each COVID-19 vaccine administered.**

38 **(5) The pharmacist shall request the name of the patient's**
39 **primary care provider prior to the administering of a COVID-19**
40 **vaccine. If the patient identifies a primary care provider to the**
41 **pharmacist, the pharmacist shall notify the primary care provider, by**
42 **written or electronic communication, as soon as reasonably possible**
43 **thereafter that the vaccine was administered.**

1 **B. At the time that a pharmacist administers a COVID-19**
2 **vaccine pursuant to the provisions of this Section, the pharmacist shall**
3 **also inform the individual that the administration of a vaccine is not to**
4 **be construed as being in lieu of an annual checkup with the individual's**
5 **primary care or family physician.**

6 **C. The provisions of this Section shall terminate on August 1,**
7 **2022."**
