HB 39 2020 Second Extraordinary Session Zeringue

APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML: Makes supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 (Item #11)

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

- 1. Directs the commissioner of administration to reduce \$92 million in Federal Funds from CARES Act funding in GOHSEP.
- 2. Adjusts the means of financing for the Louisiana Department of Health.
- 3. Transfers \$115.4 million for deposit into the Unemployment Compensation Fund.
- 4. Increases State General Fund (Direct) by \$7 million to provide funding for local government initiatives.
- 5. Transfers \$5 million to the Coronavirus Local Recovery Allocation Fund.
- 6. Reduces Judiciary Expenses by \$2 million out of CARES Act monies, replaced by \$2.4 million in State General Fund from GO bond debt refinancing.
- 7. Reduces \$45.1 million across various agencies of which \$25.4 million is State General Fund (Direct).
- 8. Transfers \$250,000 from DOTD to CPRA for sonar scanning in Southwest Pass.
- 9. Appropriates \$3.2 million of unspent FY 20 budget authority to the Legislative Budgetary Control Council for COVID-19 response efforts.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Appropriates supplemental funding and provides for means of financing substitutions and other budgetary adjustments for Fiscal Year 2020-2021. Provides for net increases (decreases) as follows: State General Fund (Direct) by \$17,151,713; Interagency Transfers by (\$78,575,770); Fees and Self-generated Revenues by (\$6,990,528); Statutory Dedications by (\$5,563,994); and Federal Funds by \$32,874,424.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
