1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 2 On page 3, line 9, change "<u>subjected to suspension or recommended for</u>" to "<u>recommended</u>
- 3 for expulsion, even if the recommendation for expulsion was reduced to a suspension,"
- 4 AMENDMENT NO. 2
- 5 On page 3, at the beginning of line 10, delete "expulsion"
- 6 AMENDMENT NO. 3
- 7 On page 3, delete lines 22 and 23 and insert the following:
- "(d) Reasonable attorney fees if the court finds any school official acted in 8 9 a grossly negligent manner; with deliberate disregard for the consequences of his 10 actions to the student; with willful or malicious indifference; with intent to deprive the student, his parent, guardian, or tutor of due process; or initiated a charge that is 11 12 knowingly false. The court may award any damages appropriate under the 13 circumstances and render any other appropriate relief including but not limited to 14 requiring the school board to issue an official apology letter, which shall be provided to the student, his parent, guardian, or tutor, and retained in the student's educational 15 records." 16
