

**HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS**

2020 Second Extraordinary Session

Amendments proposed by House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 20 by Senator Hewitt

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "(C)," delete the remainder of the line and at the beginning of line  
3 3, delete "18:401.4 and R.S. 36:744(EE)," and insert "and (D)(3) and (4),"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 5, after "requirements;" delete "to establish the Emergency Election  
6 Commission;"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, line 8, after "(C)," delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 9 and 10, and  
9 insert "and (D)(3) and (4) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 2, delete lines 2 through 5 and insert the following:

12 "reasons therefor to the governor, the Senate Committee on Senate and  
13 Governmental Affairs, and the House Committee on House and Governmental  
14 Affairs. If the governor and a majority of the members of each committee concur that  
15 such an emergency plan is"

16 AMENDMENT NO. 5

17 On page 2, line 11, after "**plans**" delete the remainder of the line

18 AMENDMENT NO. 6

19 On page 2, delete lines 15 through 20 and insert the following:

20 "of state to the Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs, the House  
21 Committee on House and Governmental Affairs, and the governor as soon as  
22 practicable following their concurrence with his certification **of emergency**. If a  
23 majority of the members of the Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental  
24 Affairs and of the House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs, **meeting**  
25 **separately or as a joint committee**, approve the **an** emergency plan,"

26 AMENDMENT NO. 7

27 On page 2, line 23, after "approve," delete the remainder of the line and insert "**an**  
28 **emergency plan, the plan shall be sent by the secretary of state to the governor, who**  
29 **shall have five days to approve or veto the plan. If the governor vetoes the plan, the**  
30 **legislature by ballot may override the veto with a two-thirds vote of each chamber**  
31 **pursuant to the procedure established in this Section. If the legislature votes to override**  
32 **the veto, the plan shall be deemed approved.**"

34 On page 2, at the beginning of line 24, insert "**Once an emergency plan is approved in the**  
35 **manner provided in this Section, the**"

2 On page 2, delete lines 28 and 29 and on page 3, delete lines 1 through 6

3 AMENDMENT NO. 10

4 On page 3, line 23, after "session," delete the remainder of the line, delete line 24, and  
5 insert "or, if the legislature is voting to override the governor's veto of the emergency  
6 election plan, ballots shall be returned within five days. The"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 11

8 On page 4, line 9, delete "mailed"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 12

10 On page 4, delete lines 20 and 21 and insert "chairmen of the Senate Committee on Senate  
11 and Governmental Affairs and House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs."

12 AMENDMENT NO. 13

13 On page 4, delete lines 23 through 29, and on page 5, delete lines 1 through 29 and insert the  
14 following:

15 "Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not  
16 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature  
17 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If  
18 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become  
19 effective on the day following such approval."
