6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 15:573.2 and 574.4.1(A)(2) are hereby amended and reenacted to
8	read as follows:
9	§573.2. Telephone Teleconference communications by certain persons
10	Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the crime victim or the victim's
11	family, a victim advocacy group, and the district attorney or his representatives
12	persons providing testimony may appear before the Board of Pardons by means of
13	teleconference or telephone communication from the office of the local district
14	attorney.

16	§574.4.1. Parole consideration and hearings

19	(2) The crime victim or the victim's family, a victim advocacy group, and the
20	district attorney or his representatives, may Persons wishing to provide testimony
21	may appear before the committee on parole by means of teleconference or telephone
22	communication from the office of the local district attorney.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.
