## SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Removes effective upon governor's signature and makes bill effective on the later of the effective date of any act that transfers funds to the Bar Assistance Relief Subaccount or any act that appropriates budget authority to the treasurer for the Bar Assistance Relief Program as provided for in HB 85 (relative to the La. Main Street Recovery Program).

# DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE 

SB 37 Engrossed 2020 Second Extraordinary Session White
Proposed law provides that upon funds becoming available for a Dept. of Transportation and Development project in the capital outlay act, the secretary shall cause the work described in the contract to be commenced immediately and expeditiously.

Proposed law provides that if a project cannot be commenced within the fiscal year for which it is planned to commence, the secretary shall file with the project records a public statement as to the factors causing the delay. The secretary shall send a copy of the public statement regarding the cause of the delay and notice when the delaying factors have been overcome semi-annually, to the Joint Legislative Committee on Capital Outlay and to each senator and representative in whose district the project is located. Further provides that when the cause of the delay has been cured, the secretary shall commence work on the project immediately and expeditiously.

Effective on the later of the effective date of any act that transfers funds to the Bar Assistance Relief Subaccount or any act that appropriates budget authority to the treasurer for the Bar Assistance Relief Program as provided for in HB 85 (relative to the La. Main Street Recovery Program).
