LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEES: Extends the termination date of the Committee on  
Minority, Female, and Veteran Enterprises

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To extend the termination date for the Committee on Minority, Female, and Veteran-Owned  
3 Enterprises to December 31, 2023.

4 WHEREAS, House Study Request No. 2 of the 2020 First Extraordinary Session of  
5 the Legislature created the Committee on Minority, Female, and Veteran-Owned Enterprises  
6 and tasked it with studying and developing a plan to promote the economic recovery and  
7 development of minority, female, and veteran-owned enterprises impacted by the COVID-19  
8 pandemic; and

9 WHEREAS, the committee met a number of times, solicited input from a wide range  
10 of governmental and business entities, and made a number of recommendations for action;  
11 and

12 WHEREAS, one of the recommendations was to extend the sunset of the committee  
13 beyond the current September 30, 2022, termination date so that it can continue to meet and  
14 study solutions for small, rural, minority, female, and veteran-owned enterprises.

15 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the  
16 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby extend the termination date for the Committee on  
17 Minority, Female, and Veteran-Owned Enterprises to December 31, 2023.
