<u>Existing law</u> requires individuals to identify themselves as a prerequisite to voting and provides that acceptable means of identification are a La. driver's license, La. special identification card, or other generally recognized picture identification card that contains the person's name and signature.

Existing law requires that a student identification card from a four-year public postsecondary education institution contain the elements of a generally recognized picture identification card.

<u>New law</u> makes this requirement applicable to each member institution of the La. Assoc. of Independent Colleges and Universities and the La. Community and Technical College System.

Existing law provides for a maximum period of validity for such student identification cards. Prior law provided that the period was four years. New law provides that it is six years.

Effective Jan. 1, 2023.
