<u>Existing law</u>, R.S. 40:2180 et seq., provides for licensure and regulation by the La. Department of Health (LDH) of intermediate care facilities for people with developmental disabilities (ICF/DD). <u>New law retains existing law</u>.

<u>New law</u> requires LDH to promulgate administrative rules to allow any close family member of an ICF/DD resident to visit the resident during any state-declared public health emergency or any public health emergency addressing the infectious respiratory disease known as COVID-19. Provides requirements for the minimum content of such rules.

<u>New law</u> stipulates that the rules adopted pursuant to <u>new law</u> shall be preempted by any federal statute, regulation, or guidance that requires an ICF/DD to restrict resident visitation in a manner that is more restrictive than those rules.

<u>New law</u> provides that, for purposes of <u>new law</u>, "close family member" means a parent, step-parent, sibling, step-sibling, aunt, uncle, child, step-child, spouse, mother-in-law, father-in-law, grandparent, grandchild, or legal representative of the ICF/DD resident.

Effective upon signature of governor (Oct. 28, 2020).
