**Abstract:** Provides for civil liability for intentionally disseminating personally identifying information.

Proposed law provides that any person who engages in the act of intentionally disseminating another's personally identifiable information that places the person in reasonable fear of death or serious bodily injury shall be civilly liable.

Proposed law defines "dissemination", "household member", and "personally identifiable information".

Proposed law does not prohibit or limit any other cause of action or infringe upon the rights of a person to use deadly force or violence for the purpose of preventing a forcible offense against the person or his property if the person's personally identifiable information is disseminated.
