PROCUREMENT CODE. Provides relative to purchase of telecommunication and video equipment or services by all state agencies. (8/1/21)

10	Section 1. R.S. 38:2237.1 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

17 C. No award of any bid<u>, contract</u>, or purchase shall be made from a vendor 18 or other entity who fails to provide the documentation required in Subsection B of 19 this Section. Any award of a bid to a contractor or purchase or contract to purchase, 20 **extend**, or renew a contract in violation of this Section shall be null and void.

21 Section 2. R.S. 39:1753.1 and 1755(5) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as 22 follows:

<u>Present law</u> prohibits all of the following entities from purchasing telecommunications or video surveillance equipment as described in Section 889(a) of the Fiscal Year 2019 National Defense Authorization Act unless such equipment is from a manufacturer that is in compliance with such federal provision:

- (1) Public elementary, secondary, and postsecondary schools, institutions, and governing authorities.
- (2) Nonpublic elementary, secondary, and postsecondary schools, institutions, and governing authorities that receive state funds.
- (3) Proprietary schools that receive state funds.

<u>Proposed law</u> broadens <u>present law</u> to prohibit all state departments, agencies, boards, or commissions from purchasing, procuring, obtain by contract, contract extension or renewal

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of any system, or as critical technology as part of any system for use by a state department, agency, board or commission that is not in compliance with Section 889(a) of the John S. McCain National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2019.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes name of federal law <u>from</u> Fiscal Year 2019 National Defense Authorization Act to John S. McCain National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2019.

<u>Present law</u> further requires the vendor of such equipment to provide an affidavit that the equipment is from a manufacturer that is in compliance with such federal provision. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and makes <u>present law</u> applicable to the purchase or acquisition of any system, or as critical technology for use by a state department, agency, board or commission under <u>proposed law</u>.

Effective August 1, 2021.
