FUNDS/PARISH TRANSPORT: Authorizes use of Parish Transportation Fund monies for mass transit in Tangipahoa Parish

1 AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 48:756(B)(1)(a) and (2)(a), relative to the Parish Transportation

Fund; to include Tangipahoa Parish as a recipient of monies from the fund dedicated

4 for mass transit purposes; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 48:756(B)(1)(a) and (2)(a) are hereby amended and reenacted to read

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8 §756. Distribution formula

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B.(1)(a) Any funds specifically appropriated for transportation purposes other than those provided for in Subsection A of this Section shall be credited to the Parish Transportation fund Fund, after appropriating two and one-half percent of the amount allocated pursuant to this Section to the public transportation section of the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development for the sole purpose of capital acquisition for the transit providers operating under 49 U.S.C. 5310 and 5311, and after providing a base amount of seventy-five thousand dollars each for mass transit purposes as defined in the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (TEA 21), or its successor, as amended, to the parish or municipal governing authority of Orleans, Jefferson, Kenner, East Baton Rouge, Monroe, Alexandria,

Abstract: Adds Tangipahoa Parish to the list of parishes receiving monies from the Parish Transportation Fund for mass transit purposes.

<u>Present law</u> establishes the Parish Transportation Fund and provides for specific uses of the fund, including mass transit operating expenses incurred by parishes and municipalities.

<u>Present law</u> provides a list of parishes that receive monies from the fund for mass transit expenses. Each parish included in the list receives a base amount of \$75,000 and an additional amount based on population and passengers prorated among the parishes.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds Tangipahoa Parish to the list of parishes that receive monies from the fund for mass transit purposes.
