2 To enact R.S. 32:388(B)(4)(b)(xv), relative to construction aggregates; to expand the  
3 definition of "construction aggregates" to include dirt; and to provide for related  
4 matters.

6 Section 1. R.S. 32:388(B)(4)(b)(xv) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

**Abstract:** Expands the definition of "construction aggregates" to include dirt.

Present law defines "construction aggregates" as any of the following: sand, gravel, crushed stone, reef shell, clam shell, sand-clam shell mixture, sand-reef shell mixture, sand clay gravel, clam-reef shell mixture, crushed concrete, expanded clay, calcium sulfate hemihydrate, asphalt, and bulk soil.

Proposed law expands the definition of "construction aggregates" to include dirt.
