#### Abstract

AN ACT

To redesignate a portion of United States Highway 171 in Shreveport, Louisiana, as the "Elbert W. 'Eddie' Giles Memorial Highway"; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: Section 1. The portion of United States Highway 171, otherwise known as Hearne Avenue, from the three-hundred through the four-hundred block, in Shreveport, Louisiana, shall be known and hereby redesignated as the "Elbert W. 'Eddie' Giles Memorial Highway".

Section 2. The Department of Transportation and Development or its contractors are hereby directed to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting this designation provided local or private monies are received by the department equal to the department's actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of each sign, not to exceed the sum of five hundred fifty dollars per sign.
