2	To amend and reenact R.S. 17:164.2(A) and 3996(B)(54) and to repeal R.S. 17:164.2(C),		
3	relative to school buses; to require that school buses be equipped with occupant		
4	restraint systems; to provide relative to funding; and to provide for related matters.		
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:		
6	Section 1. R.S. 17:164.2 and 3996(B)(54) are hereby amended and reenacted to read		
7	as follows:		
8	§164.2. Additional regulations; occupant restraint systems required; compliance		
9	A. In addition to any regulations adopted by the State Board of Elementar		
10	and Secondary Education pursuant to the provisions of R.S. 17:164 relative to th		
11	construction, design, equipment, and operation of school buses used in the		
12	transportation of students, the board also shall adopt rules and regulations in		
13	accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act and any applicable federa		
14	standards to require that every bus used primarily for the transportation of studen		
15	shall be equipped with occupant restraint systems by not later than June 30, 2004

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Abstract: Requires school buses to be equipped with seat belts.

<u>Present law</u> requires the State Bd. of Elementary and Secondary Education to adopt rules and regulations to require that every bus used primarily for the transportation of students be equipped with occupant restraint systems; however, <u>present law</u> is subject to the appropriation of funds. <u>Proposed law</u> repeals this funding condition and applies the occupant restraint system requirement to charter school buses.

Proposed law requires implementation by Jan. 1, 2025.
