Abstract: Requires installation of water bottle filling stations in new public school buildings and existing school buildings undergoing major renovations.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires installation of water bottle filling stations at a new public school building and an existing public school building that undergoes a major renovation. Applies to construction and major renovations that commence on or after Aug. 31, 2021.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "water bottle filling station" as a water dispenser, accessible to all people in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, that dispenses clean drinking water directly into a bottle or other drinking container.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "major renovation" as changes to an existing school building that provide significant opportunities for substantial improvement or an extensive alteration.
