Abstract: Provides for changes to the board of directors of the Acadia Parish Convention and Visitors Commission.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the governing authority of any parish may form and create a tourist commission.

<u>Present law</u> specifically creates certain tourist commissions including the Acadia Parish Convention and Visitors Commission composed of all the territory in Acadia Parish.

<u>Present law</u> provides that, unless provided otherwise, a commission shall be governed by a board of seven directors to be appointed by the governing authority of the parish.

<u>Present law</u> provides that, unless provided otherwise, appointments shall be made from a list of nominees submitted to the governing authority by private, nonprofit groups that have an interest in one or more aspects of the tourism industry.

<u>Present law</u> provides for an exception with respect to the Acadia Parish Convention and Visitors Commission. Provides that the commission shall be governed by a board of 11 directors. <u>Proposed</u> law changes the total number of directors appointed by the parish governing authority from 11 to 12.

<u>Proposed law</u> further authorizes the board to appoint a 13th member to the board. Requires majority vote for such an appointment, and provides that it need not be made from lists of nominees as provided for by <u>present law</u>. Also authorizes the board to decide that it will no longer utilize the additional member authorized by <u>proposed law</u>, but provides that such a decision will become effective only when there is a vacancy in the position. Otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.
