Abstract: Provides requirements for notice to be sent by a mayor's court relative to the operation of motor vehicles, requires a mayor's court to pay any fees due for erroneous violations, and provides for penalties for erroneously submitted violations.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires a mayor's court to mail a notice to the address on the defendant's Louisiana operator's license at least 20 days prior to any submission pursuant to <u>present law</u> to suspend the operator's license.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires a mayor's court to pay any fees due to the department for an erroneously submitted violation.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that a mayor's court's ability to submit notices shall be revoked for a period of 12 months upon submission of 5 or more erroneous violations in a 12 month period.
