1 AN ACT 2 To enact R.S. 40:1730.23(J), relative to enforcement of the state uniform construction code; 3 to provide for inspections of commercial and residential structures; to prohibit 4 remote virtual inspections of such structures; and to provide for related matters. 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 6 Section 1. R.S. 40:1730.23(J) is hereby enacted to read as follows: 7 §1730.23. Enforcement of building codes by municipalities and parishes 8 9 J. It shall be unlawful for any person to perform a remote virtual inspection 10 of any commercial or residential structure in lieu of a physical onsite inspection by 11 a properly registered certified building inspector in this state.

Abstract: Prohibits virtual inspections of commercial or residential structures to enforce the state uniform construction code.

<u>Present law</u> regulates the enforcement of the state uniform construction code.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds a restriction prohibiting remote virtual inspections in lieu of physical onsite inspections by a registered certified building inspector.
