Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

HIGHWAYS: Redesignates a portion of Interstate 220 in Shreveport, Louisiana, as the "Minnion Dewayne Jackson Memorial Highway"

1 AN ACT

2 To redesignate a portion of Interstate 220 in Shreveport, Louisiana, as "Minnion Dewayne
3 Jackson Memorial Highway"; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. The portion of Interstate 220 otherwise designated as the "Joseph D.
6 Waggoner, Jr. Highway" located in Bossier City and Shreveport, Louisiana, shall be known
7 and is hereby redesignated as the "Minnion Dewayne Jackson Memorial Highway" at Exit
8 7A.

9 Section 2. The Department of Transportation and Development or its contractors are
10 hereby directed to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting this designation
11 provided local or private monies are received by the department equal to the department's
12 actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of each sign, not to
13 exceed the sum of five hundred fifty dollars per sign.

Redesignates Interstate 220, specifically at Exit 7A, in Shreveport, La., as the "Minnion Dewayne Jackson Memorial Highway".

Directs the Dept. of Transportation and Development (DOTD) to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting this highway designation provided local or private monies are

received by the DOTD equal to its actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of each sign, not to exceed the sum of \$550 per sign.
