Increases hunting license fees for to provide funding for hog eradication and processing program

Under <u>present law</u>, a basic hunting license for residents is \$15, and revenues received from the sale of these licenses are dedicated to specified wildlife and fisheries causes. <u>Proposed law</u> increases the license fee from \$15 to \$16 and dedicates the additional \$1 to the Hunters for the Hungry Hog Eradication and Processing Account within the Conservation Fund. <u>Proposed law</u> requires \$0.75 received used for hog processing through the Hunters for the Hungry program and the remaining \$0.25 used for marketing and promotion of the hog processing program.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

Proposed law will increase revenues in the newly created Hungry Hog Eradication and Processing Account within the Conservation Fund. The proposed law increases the license fee from \$15 to \$16. The revenue generated from the \$1 increase would be placed into the newly created Hungry Hog Eradication and Processing Account, which can only be used for hog processing through the Hunters for the Hungry program as well as marketing and promotion of the hog processing program. Based on the number of resident basic hunting licenses sold in 2020, the estimated annual revenue increase is \$125,893 (125,893 hunting license sold x \$1) under this measure.
