2 To commend Ascension Parish registrar of voters, Robert Poché, on the occasion of his
3 retirement.

4 WHEREAS, Robert Poché has served as the Ascension Parish registrar of voters for
5 nearly forty years; and

6 WHEREAS, the parish registrar's office plays a vital role in elections by verifying
7 registered voters and determining polling locations and precinct boundaries; the office also
8 manages the occasional recall petition by verifying signatures belonging to registered voters;
9 and

10 WHEREAS, under Mr. Poché, the Ascension Parish registrar's office has also been
11 involved in the redistricting of the parish council and other local governing bodies after each
12 decennial census; and

13 WHEREAS, fair elections are critical to Louisiana's democracy and Robert Poché
14 is most deserving of recognition for nearly four decades of faithful service to Ascension
15 Parish and the state of Louisiana.

16 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
17 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend Ascension Parish registrar of voters, Robert
18 Poché, on the occasion of his retirement; does hereby thank Mr. Poché for his commitment
19 to safeguarding the integrity of democracy in Ascension Parish; and does hereby extend
20 sincere hopes and wishes that he enjoy a fulfilling life in retirement.
