1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, at the end of line 11, insert the following:

3 "If the commissioner seeks injunctive relief against a solicitor who violates this
4 Section to enjoin the unlawful use of the name, trade name, trademark, service mark,
5 or loan information, the commissioner shall not be required to prove actual damages
6 as a result of the violation. Irreparable harm shall be presumed. If the commissioner
7 prevails in any action brought pursuant to this Section, the commissioner shall be
8 entitled to recover costs associated with the action and reasonable attorney fees from
9 the solicitor. Any action brought by the commissioner pursuant to this Subsection
10 shall be brought in the Nineteenth Judicial District Court."
