Proposed legislation requires the Peace Officer Standards Training Council (POST) to develop and implement curriculum to provide instruction for law enforcement personnel on the duty to intervene, no later than January 1, 2022. Proposed legislation requires law enforcement agencies that use body cameras to adopt a policy regarding the activation and deactivation of the camera by January 1, 2022. Proposed legislation prohibits the use of choke holds and carotid holds and no-knock warrants, except under specific circumstances enumerated in the legislation.

Effective August 1, 2021.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There will be an increase in SGF expenditures for the Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement (LCLE) as a result of the proposed legislation. LCLE reports a one-time increase of \$28,000 SGF in order to develop the interactive video training module for law enforcement personnel on the duty to intervene for the Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST).

The other provisions of the proposed legislation are policy changes and will not have a fiscal impact on state agencies.
