Express warranties; time limit to conform 14 A.(1) It shall be presumed that a reasonable number of attempts have been undertaken to conform a motor vehicle to the applicable express warranties if the 15 16 vehicle is out of service by reason of repair for a cumulative total of forty-five or 17 more calendar days or the same nonconformity has been subject to repair four or 18 more times by the manufacturer, its agent, or its authorized dealer within the 19 warranty term or during a period of one year following the date of the original 20 delivery of the motor vehicle to the consumer, whichever is the earlier date. 21 (2)(a) Notwithstanding the provisions of Paragraph (1) of this Subsection, in 22 the case of a motor home, the consumer shall provide written notification to the 23 manufacturer of any of the following: 24 (i) The need to repair the nonconformity. 25 (ii) Evidence of a cumulative total of at least ninety days of the motor home 26 being out of service. 27 (iii) Evidence that the same nonconformity has been subject to repair four or 28 more times by the manufacturer, its agent, or its authorized dealer within the 29 warranty term or during a period of one year following the date of the original 30 delivery of the motor vehicle to the consumer, whichever is the earlier date. 31 (b) Upon such notification, the manufacturer shall have a final attempt to 32 repair the vehicle. The manufacturer shall have five business days upon receipt of 33 such notification to respond to the consumer as to where the motor home may be 34 delivered for repair. The repair facility shall be one which is authorized by the 35 manufacturer to perform the necessary warranty work. 36 (c) Once delivered, the repair facility shall have ten business days within 37 which to conform the vehicle to the applicable warranty. The time periods provided 38 for in this Paragraph may only be extended if the consumer authorizes such 39 extension in writing. (3) If a manufacturer fails to respond to the consumer or to perform the 40 41 repairs within the time periods described in Paragraphs (1) and (2) of this Subsection, 42 such manufacturer shall be deemed to have waived his rights to a final attempt to 43 cure the nonconformity. 44 45 §1944. Motor vehicle replacement or refund 46 47 48

A. If a nonconformity in a motor home has not been repaired within the time periods provided for in R.S. 32:1943(A)(2), or if after four or more attempts within the express warranty term or during a period of one year following the date of the original delivery to the consumer of a motor vehicle which is not a motor home, whichever is the earlier, the nonconformity has not been repaired or if the vehicle is out of service by reason of repair for a cumulative total of ninety forty-five or more calendar days during the warranty period, the manufacturer shall:
