



1           WHEREAS, the best means of preventing West Nile disease is to reduce exposure  
2 to mosquitos by removing standing water, using mosquito repellent, wearing long-sleeved  
3 shirts and long pants when outdoors, and limiting outside activity during dawn, dusk, and  
4 early evening, when the insects are most active; and

5           WHEREAS, with the approach of warmer weather, Louisianians are advised to take  
6 precautions to protect themselves and their loved ones from West Nile virus, and recognizing  
7 April as West Nile Virus Awareness Month can help educate the public about this  
8 preventable disease.

9           THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby  
10 recognize April 2021 as West Nile Virus Awareness Month in Louisiana, and hereby  
11 encourages Louisianians to learn more about ways to stop the spread of West Nile virus.
