CAPITAL OUTLAY Provides an exception for late approval of a capital outlay request for a state-owned and administered project submitted by a budget unit of the state, including public postsecondary education institutions. (gov sig) (2/3 - CA7s11(C))

The proposed law allows state-owned and administered projects submitted by a budget unit of the state including public postsecondary education institutions that are included in the capital outlay act to the list of projects, which may be submitted after November 1st and included in the capital outlay bill. The provisions of the proposed law does not apply to a political subdivision that is also a budget unit of the state.
