2 On page 1, line 2, after "and 222," insert "and to enact R.S. 17:221(E),"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 6, between "reenacted" and "to" insert "and R.S. 17:221(E) is hereby
5 enacted"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, line 13, after "child" enter a period "."

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 2, line 15, after "public or" change "private" to "**nonpublic**"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 5

11 On page 2, line 23, after "**public or**" change "**private**" to "**nonpublic**"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 6

13 On page 3, line 17, after "public or" change "private" to "**nonpublic**"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 7

15 On page 3, at the end of line 23, change "**private**" to "**nonpublic**"

16 AMENDMENT NO. 8

17 On page 3, between lines 24 and 25 insert the following:

18 **"(3) Nothing in this Section shall be construed to prohibit a child from**
19 **being enrolled in and attending kindergarten in a home study program."**

20 AMENDMENT NO. 9

21 On page 4, on line 3, after "public or" change "private" to "**nonpublic** "

22 AMENDMENT NO. 10

23 On page 4, line 9, after "**public or**" change "**private school**" to "**nonpublic school, as**
24 **defined by R.S. 17:236,**"

25 AMENDMENT NO. 11

26 On page 4, between lines 18 and 19 insert the following:

27 **"E.(1) Nothing in this Section shall be construed to prohibit a child from**
28 **enrolling in an approved home study program or a nonpublic school not seeking**
29 **state approval. The parent or legal guardian responsible for the school**
30 **attendance of such a child, who is between the ages of five and eighteen, shall**
31 **report the attendance of the child to the state Department of Education within**
32 **thirty days of the start of the school term as provided in R.S. 17:232(C).**

1 (2) A parent or legal guardian responsible for the school attendance of
2 a child who is between the ages of five and eighteen and who is enrolled in an
3 approved home study program pursuant to R.S. 17:236.1 shall be considered in
4 compliance with the school attendance provisions of Paragraph (A)(1) of this
5 Section.
