Abstract: Provides for publication requirements for sheriff sales.

<u>Present law</u> (C.C.P. Art. 2331) provides for the publication of notice of the sale of property under a writ of fieri facias shall be published twice for immovable property.

<u>Proposed law</u> (C.C.P. Art. 2331) retains <u>present law</u> but provides that if a judicial sale of immovable property is rescheduled, the notice of sale of property shall be published once.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Civil Law and Procedure</u> to the original bill:

1. Remove references and changes to R.S. 43:201(A), which provides for judicial advertisements and legal notices for parishes outside of Orleans Parish.

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Remove provisions amending R.S. 43:201(A), relative to the publication of notices of judicial sales.
