The proposed law repeals the present law exception of a local match requirement for non-state entity projects of rural water systems servicing less than 1,250 customers. The proposed law increases the number of customers population served from less than 1,250 to fewer than 5,000. The proposed law applies to the funding of all non-state entity projects in the capital outlay budget commencing on or after 7/1/2021.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure since the number of capital outlay projects and the amount of capital outlay spending are functions of the state's available debt capacity which is not impacted by the proposed change to non-state entity projects. The line of credit for non-state entity projects are currently limited to no more than 25% of the cash line of credit for projects, therefore the same total amount will be appropriated for non-state entity projects. Enactment of the proposed legislation may encourage some water systems to apply for capital outlay funds since a local match is not required. This may impact how the total line of credit for non-state entity projects basis.

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
