



1           Section 3. This application shall be considered as covering the same subject matter  
2 as the applications from other states to Congress to call a convention to set a limit on the  
3 number of terms that a person may be elected to the House of Representatives of the  
4 Congress of the United States and the Senate of the United States; and this application shall  
5 be aggregated with same for the purpose of attaining the two-thirds of states necessary to  
6 require Congress to call a limited convention on this subject, but shall not be aggregated with  
7 any other applications on any other subject.

8           Section 4. This application constitutes a continuing application in accordance with  
9 Article V of the Constitution of the United States of America until the legislatures of at least  
10 two-thirds of the several states have made applications on the same subject.

11           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the  
12 secretary of state.
