**HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENTS**

Amendments proposed by Representative Bacala to Engrossed House Bill No. 325 by Representative Larvadain

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 8, after the semicolon ";" and before the "and" insert "to provide for  
3 exceptions;"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 19, after "children" delete the remainder of the line and delete line 20 in its  
6 entirety and insert "under his care, custody, or control at the time of the arrest."

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 2, at the beginning of line 24, insert "A."

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 2, line 27, after "child" and before "who" insert "under the care, custody, or control  
11 of the arrested person at the time of the arrest,"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 5

14 On page 3, line 4, change "caregiver" to "person"

15 AMENDMENT NO. 6

16 On page 3, line 6, after "child" and before the comma "," insert "under his care, custody, or  
17 control"

18 AMENDMENT NO. 7

19 On page 3, line 9, change "caregiver" to "person"

20 AMENDMENT NO. 8

21 On page 3, after line 16, add the following:

22 "B. Law enforcement officers are not required to adhere to the  
23 guidelines of Subsection A of this Section if any of the following  
24 circumstances are present:

25 (1) The arrested caregiver presents a threat of serious bodily injury  
26 or death to himself, others, or the law enforcement officer.

27 (2) The arrested caregiver is in the act of committing a crime of  
28 violence as defined in R.S. 14:2(B).

29 (3) The law enforcement officer has exercised due diligence, based  
30 on all available information, and ascertains that no minor children are under  
31 the arrested person's care, custody, or control."
