 Authorizes a pilot program implementing a balanced calendar at certain schools

Proposed law requires the Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) and the Department of Education (LDE) to implement a pilot program for purposes of reviewing a balanced calendar school year. Provides that LDE may use COVID-19 federal stimulus funds to provide grants to assist governing authorities for such purpose, subject to appropriation. Requires LDE to annually report recommendations to the House and Senate Committees on Education for legislation that addresses issues associated with supporting a balanced calendar school year no later than 30 days prior to the Regular Session.

**EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

At this time, such costs are indeterminable and impacts may vary between districts depending on implementation strategies.
