For the purposes of this Section, "peace officers" shall include 18 19 commissioned police officers, sheriffs, deputy sheriffs, marshals, deputy marshals, correctional officers, constables, wildlife enforcement agents, state 20 park wardens, probation and parole officers, military police officers, security 21 personnel employed by the Supreme Court of Louisiana or a court of appeal 22 23 of Louisiana, and an officer, employee, contract worker, or volunteer with 24 any prison, jail, work release facility, or correctional institution. "Peace officers" shall also include any employee of the state, a municipality, or other 25 26 public agency whose permanent duties include the making of arrests, 27 performing of searches and seizures, or executing criminal warrants, preventing or detecting crime, or enforcing the penal, traffic, or highway 28
