A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To commend the members of the United States Armed Forces for their service and to
proclaim May 2021 as Military Appreciation Month.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Armed Forces are spread around the world in more than one

service members and their families, and communicating to our service members our vast
