- 8 On page 5, delete line 11 in its entirety and in lieu thereof insert the following:
 - "(5)(6) Except as provided in R.S. 30:2155.1, the department shall collect from each facility permitted as a construction or demolition debris landfill, as part of the annual monitoring and maintenance fee, a fee not exceeding twenty-five cents per ton of construction or demolition debris deposited in the facility. The fee provided for in this Paragraph shall apply only to construction or demolition debris which is subject to a fee imposed by the facility. The secretary is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations to implement this Paragraph.
 - (6)(7) The department may require a fee to process any request for a declaratory ruling not to exceed the maximum per-hour overtime salary, including associated-related benefits, of a civil service employee of the department per hour or portion thereof required to conduct the review plus reasonable indirect costs calculated as a percentage of the hourly fee. Such percentage shall be determined annually by agreement between the department and the United States Environmental Protection Agency for use on grants and contracts. However, the department may require a requestor to pay a minimum fee of one thousand five hundred dollars."
