# BY REPRESENTATIVES SCHEXNAYDER AND ZERINGUE AND SENATOR CORTEZ

Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

FUNDS/FUNDING-GRANTS: Provides for the disbursement of monies received from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 39:100.44.1 and Subpart N of Part II-A of Chapter 1 of Subtitle I of Title 39
3	of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, to be comprised of R.S. 39:100.51
4	through 100.56, relative to the disbursement of monies received from the American
5	Rescue Plan Act of 2021; to create funds for the deposit of federal monies received
6	from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021; to create programs for the
7	administration of monies from the funds; to provide for an effective date; and to
8	provide for related matters.
9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
10	Section 1. R.S. 39:100.44.1 and Subpart N of Part II-A of Chapter 1 of Subtitle I of
11	Title 39 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 39:100.51 through
12	100.56, are hereby enacted to read as follows:
13	§100.44.1. Louisiana Main Street Recovery Program; Louisiana Rescue Plan Funds
14	A. Notwithstanding the provisions of R.S. 39:100.44, the treasurer shall
15	utilize the resources of the Louisiana Main Street Recovery Program to administer
16	the Louisiana Loggers Relief Program and the Louisiana Save Our Screens Program
17	as provided in this Section. The treasurer may utilize up to five percent of the
18	monies in the Louisiana Loggers Relief Fund and the Louisiana Save Our Screens

1	Fund for administration of the programs. Notwithstanding any provision of law to		
2	the contrary, the treasurer may enter into consulting services, professional services,		
3	and information and technology services contracts for the purpose of the		
4	procurement of any goods or services necessary to implement and expedite the		
5	distribution of funds as emergency procurements exempt from the provisions of the		
6	Louisiana Procurement Code and corresponding rules and regulations. The cost of		
7	such contracts shall be considered administrative expenses.		
8	B. Any business receiving funding from a program within the Louisiana		
9	Main Street Recovery Program pursuant to this Section shall meet the following		
10	criteria:		
11	(1) Had a physical and active operation in Louisiana as of March 1, 2020.		
12	(2) Had fifty or fewer full-time equivalent employees as of March 1, 2020.		
13	(3) Filed Louisiana taxes for tax years 2019 and 2020.		
14	(4) Experienced a revenue loss of ten percent or greater of gross revenue for		
15	the period of January 1, 2020, through December 31, 2020, as compared to the gross		
16	revenue of the business during the same period in 2019.		
17	(5) Is in good standing with the secretary of state.		
18	(6) Does not exist for the purpose of advancing partisan political activity.		
19	(7) Does not directly lobby federal or state officials.		
20	(8) Does not derive income from passive investments without active		
21	participation in business operations.		
22	C. Any grant award received pursuant to this Section combined with any		
23	monies received pursuant to the Louisiana Main Street Recovery Program as		
24	provided in R.S. 39:100.44, United States Small Business Administration-Guaranty		
25	Paycheck Protection Program loan, and United States Small Business Administration		
26	Economic Injury Disaster Loan Emergency Advance shall not exceed the amount of		
27	revenue loss experienced by the business during the period provided for in		
28	Subsection (B)(4) of this Section.		

1	D. Priority shall be given to businesses that previously submitted	
2	applications to the Louisiana Main Street Recovery Program as provided in R.S.	
3	39:100.44 but whose applications were not considered due to exhaustion of monies	
4	in the Louisiana Main Street Recovery Fund.	
5	E. The Louisiana Loggers Relief Program is hereby established as a	
6	component of the Louisiana Main Street Recovery Program. The program shall	
7	provide grants to eligible timber harvesting and timber hauling businesses impacted	
8	by COVID-19. Any grant received pursuant to this Subsection shall not exceed	
9	twenty-five thousand dollars per business. In addition to the criteria provided in	
10	Subsection B of this Section, a timber harvesting or timber hauling business shall	
11	meet all of the following criteria to be eligible to receive a grant:	
12	(1) Is assigned a North American Industry Classification System Code of	
13	<u>113310 or 484220.</u>	
14	(2) Is certified by the Louisiana Forestry Association as a master logger.	
15	(3) Is not a subsidiary of a business with more than fifty full-time equivalent	
16	employees, is not part of a larger business enterprise with more than fifty full-time	
17	equivalent employees, and is not owned by a business with more than fifty full-time	
18	equivalent employees.	
19	F. The Louisiana Save Our Screens Program is hereby established as a	
20	component of the Louisiana Main Street Recovery Program. The program shall	
21	provide grants to eligible movie theater businesses impacted by COVID-19. Any	
22	grant received pursuant to this Subsection shall not exceed ten thousand dollars per	
23	movie screen located in Louisiana. Theatres with corporate ownership based outside	
24	of Louisiana shall use funds received pursuant to this Subsection for Louisiana-based	
25	screens and operations. In addition to the criteria provided in Subsection B of this	
26	Section, a business shall meet all of the following criteria to be eligible to receive a	
27	grant:	

1	(1) Is a movie theater that has at least one permanent indoor auditorium for $(1)$	
2	viewing films for entertainment by the general public who attend by the purchase of	
3	an individual ticket to view a specific non-adult-oriented film.	
4	(2) Conducted regularly scheduled screenings in Louisiana in calendar year	
5	<u>2019.</u>	
6	(3) Is currently open and actively operating as of the effective date of this	
7	Section.	
8	(4) Was subject to limitations or restrictions as a result of Proclamation	
9	Number 25 JBE 2020 or any subsequent gubernatorial proclamations related to	
10	<u>COVID-19.</u>	
11	SUBPART N. LOUISIANA RESCUE PLAN FUND	
12	§100.51. Louisiana Rescue Plan Fund; purpose	
13	A. There is hereby created in the state treasury, as a special fund, the	
14	"Louisiana Rescue Plan Fund", hereinafter referred to in this Section as the "fund".	
15	B. Except for four hundred million dollars which shall be paid to the	
16	Clearing Account of the Unemployment Compensation Fund pursuant to R.S.	
17	23:1491, the state treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to deposit in and credit	
18	to the fund any federal monies allocated to Louisiana pursuant to Coronavirus State	
19	Fiscal Recovery Fund of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.	
20	C. Monies in the fund shall be invested in the same manner as monies in the	
21	state general fund. Interest earned on investment of monies in the fund shall be	
22	credited to the fund. Unexpended and unencumbered monies in the fund at the end	
23	of the fiscal year shall remain in the fund.	
24	D. Monies in the fund shall be allocated as provided in this Subpart.	
25	E. If the legislature is not in session, the Joint Legislative Committee on the	
26	Budget is authorized to appropriate monies from the Louisiana Rescue Plan Fund or	
27	any of the funds created pursuant to this Subpart. Any such appropriation shall be	
28	consistent with guidance promulgated by the United States Treasury. The committee	

1	is further authorized to approve the transfer of funds between any of the funds	
2	created pursuant to this Subpart.	
3	§100.52. Louisiana Water Infrastructure Fund	
4	A. There is hereby created in the state treasury, as a special fund, the	
5	Louisiana Water Infrastructure Fund, hereinafter referred to in this Section as the	
6	"fund". The treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer three hundred	
7	million dollars from the Louisiana Rescue Plan Fund into the Louisiana Water	
8	Infrastructure Fund.	
9	B. Monies in the fund shall be invested in the same manner as monies in the	
10	state general fund. Interest earned on the investment of monies in the fund shall be	
11	deposited in and credited to the fund.	
12	C. Monies in the fund shall be used to provide grant funding for repairs,	
13	improvements, and consolidation of water systems and sewerage systems pursuant	
14	to the Louisiana Water Infrastructure Program as provided in R.S. 39:100.56.	
15	§100.53. Granting Unserved Municipalities Broadband Opportunities Fund	
16	A. There is hereby created in the state treasury, as a special fund, the	
17	Granting Unserved Municipalities Broadband Opportunities (GUMBO) Fund,	
18	hereinafter referred to in this Section as the "fund". The treasurer is hereby	
19	authorized and directed to transfer ninety million dollars from the Louisiana Rescue	
20	Plan Fund into the fund.	
21	B. All unexpended and unencumbered monies in the fund at the end of the	
22	fiscal year shall remain in the fund. Monies in the fund shall be invested in the same	
23	manner as monies in the state general fund. Interest earned on the investment of	
24	monies in the fund shall be deposited in and credited to the fund.	
25	C. Monies in the fund shall be used to provide grants to help fund broadband	
26	access in rural and disadvantaged areas pursuant to the provisions of the Granting	
27	Unserved Municipalities Broadband Opportunities program established by law.	

1	§100.54. Louisiana Loggers Relief Fund	
2	A. There is hereby created in the state treasury, as a special fund, the	
3	Louisiana Loggers Relief Fund, hereinafter referred to in this Section as the "fund".	
4	The treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer ten million dollars from	
5	the Louisiana Rescue Plan Fund into the fund. Monies in the fund shall be used to	
6	provide economic support grants to eligible Louisiana timber harvesting and timber	
7	hauling businesses in accordance with the provisions of the Louisiana Loggers Relief	
8	Program as provided in R.S. 39:100.44.1.	
9	B. Monies in the fund shall be invested in the same manner as monies in the	
10	state general fund. Interest earned on the investment of monies in the fund shall be	
11	deposited in and credited to the fund.	
12	C. Any remaining balance in the fund on January 1, 2022, shall be	
13	transferred to the Louisiana Rescue Plan Fund.	
14	§100.55. Louisiana Save Our Screens Fund	
15	A. There is hereby created in the state treasury, as a special fund, the	
16	Louisiana Save Our Screens Fund, hereinafter referred to in this Section as the	
17	"fund". The treasurer is hereby authorized to transfer four million five hundred	
18	thousand dollars from the Louisiana Rescue Plan Fund into the fund. Monies in the	
19	fund shall be used to provide economic support grants to eligible movie theater	
20	owners and operators in accordance with the Louisiana Save Our Screens Program	
21	as provided in R.S. 39:100.44.1.	
22	B. Monies in the fund shall be invested in the same manner as monies in the	
23	state general fund. Interest earned on the investment of monies in the fund shall be	
24	deposited in and credited to the fund.	
25	C. Any remaining balance in the fund on January 1, 2022, shall be	
26	transferred to the Louisiana Rescue Plan Fund.	

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1	<u>§100.56.</u> Louisiana Water Infrastructure Program		
2	A. As used in this Section, the following terms shall have the following		
3	meanings:		
4	(1) "Committee" shall mean the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget.		
5	(2) "Office" shall mean the office of public health in the Louisiana		
6	Department of Health.		
7	(3) "Fund" shall mean the Louisiana Water Infrastructure Fund.		
8	B. The Louisiana Water Infrastructure Program is hereby established to		
9	provide grant funding for repairs, improvements, and consolidation of community		
10	water systems. The office shall administer the program. The office shall establish		
11	a review panel comprised of employees of the office, the office of community		
12	development in the division of administration, the Department of Environmental		
13	Quality, and the legislative auditor. The review panel shall review and rate		
14	applications submitted by community water systems and local governing authorities		
15	and submit recommendations for funding to the Joint Legislative Committee on the		
16	Budget.		
17	C. The office shall promulgate rules for the administration of the program.		
18	The rules shall include application requirements, a timeline for application		
19	submissions and approval, criteria for ratings, a process for prioritizing critical		
20	infrastructure needs, and requirements for waivers of matching funds or decreased		
21	match. The Administrative Procedure Act, R.S. 49:950 et seq., shall not apply to		
22	rules promulgated pursuant to this Section. No later than ninety days after the		
23	effective date of this Section, the office shall submit the rules to the committee for		
24	review and approval. Any changes to the initial rules shall require approval by the		
25	committee.		
26	D. In addition to the rules provided for in Subsection C of this Section, the		
27	office shall submit a proposed budget outlining administrative expenses for the		
28	program to the committee for review and approval prior to implementing the		
29	program.		

1	E. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the office may enter		
2	into consulting services, professional services, and information and technology		
3	services contracts for the purpose of the procurement of any goods or services		
4	necessary to implement and expedite the distribution of funds as emergence		
5	procurements exempt from the provisions of the Louisiana Procurement Code and		
6	corresponding rules and regulations. The cost of such contracts shall be considered		
7	administrative expenses.		
8	F. Each grant recipient shall be required to provide matching funds unless		
9	the review panel recommends waiving the match requirement.		
10	G. Upon committee approval of the rules, the office shall begin accepting		
11	applications. The applications shall include the following, at a minimum:		
12	(1) The amount of grant funding requested.		
13	(2) The amount and proposed source of funding for the required match.		
14	(3) Proposals for repairs, improvements, or consolidation with neighboring		
15	systems.		
16	(4) Proposals for ensuring the financial sustainability and compliance of the		
17	systems, including proposals for increasing rates paid by users of the system based		
18	on a fair assessment of the system to comparable systems.		
19	H. The review panel's funding recommendations to the committee shall		
20	include:		
21	(1) Recommendations for utilization of existing resources including the		
22	Drinking Water Revolving Loan Fund, Clean Water State Revolving Fund, and		
23	Community Water Enrichment and Other Improvements Fund.		
24	(2) Certification that the local governing authority that operates the system		
25	either utilized funding received pursuant to the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery		
26	Fund of the American Rescue Act Plan of 2021 as the source of funding for the		
27	required match or had legitimate cause that precluded the use of those funds for the		
28	match.		

1	I. Upon approval of any funding recommendations, the committee may	
2	appropriate monies from the fund to the system or local governing authority that	
3	operates the system.	
4	J. No money shall be expended from the fund without approval of the	
5	committee.	
6	K. The provisions of R.S. 39:72.1(A) shall not apply to monies appropriated	
7	from the fund pursuant to this Section.	
8	Section 2.(A) This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if	
9	not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without	
10	signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of	
11	Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act	
12	shall become effective on the day following such approval.	
13	(B) Notwithstanding the provisions of Paragraph (A) of this Section, R.S. 39:100.53	
14	as enacted by the provisions of this Act shall become effective if and when the Act which	
15	originated as House Bill No. 648 of this 2021 Regular Session of the Legislature is enacted	
16	and becomes effective.

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Abstract: Creates funds and programs to administer monies from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.

<u>Proposed law</u> creates the Louisiana Rescue Plan Fund and directs the treasurer to deposit any federal monies allocated to Louisiana pursuant to Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, except \$400 million to be paid to the Unemployment Compensation Fund, into the fund.

<u>Proposed law</u> creates the following funds and directs the treasurer to deposit the following amounts into the funds:

- (1) Louisiana Water Infrastructure Fund \$300 million
- (2) Granting Unserved Municipalities Broadband Opportunities (GUMBO) Fund- \$90 million
- (3) Louisiana Loggers Relief Fund \$10 million

# (4) Louisiana Save Our Screens Fund - \$4.5 million

#### Louisiana Water Infrastructure Program

<u>Proposed law</u> creates the Louisiana Water Infrastructure Program to provide grants to community water systems and sewer systems. Requires the office of public health to administer the program and to submit proposed rules for the administration of the program to JLCB within 90 days of the effective date of the bill.

<u>Proposed law</u> establishes a review panel comprised of the office of public health, Dept. of Environmental Quality, office of community development, and the legislative auditor to review and rate applications from local governments and water and sewer systems and make recommendations to JLCB for funding projects.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides requirements for certain information to be included with a local governing authority or system's application and the review panel's recommendations to JLCB.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes JLCB to appropriate funds to the system or local governing authority upon approval of the review panel's funding recommendation and prohibits any money from being expended from the Louisiana Water Infrastructure Fund without JLCB approval.

## Louisiana Loggers Relief Program

<u>Proposed law</u> creates the Louisiana Loggers Relief Program to provide grants to timber harvesting and timber hauling businesses who suffered revenue loss due to COVID-19.

<u>Proposed law</u> establishes the program as a component of the Louisiana Main Street Recovery Program and outlines criteria for program eligibility.

Proposed law limits the grant amount to \$25,000 per eligible business.

#### Louisiana Save Our Screens Program

<u>Proposed law</u> creates the Louisiana Save Our Screens Program to provide grants to movie theaters in La. who were forced to close or reduce capacity due to COVID-19.

<u>Proposed law</u> establishes the program as a component of the Louisiana Main Street Recovery Program and outlines criteria for program eligibility.

Proposed law limits the grant amount to \$10,000 per movie screen located in La.

#### Granting Unserved Municipalities Broadband Opportunities (GUMBO) Fund

<u>Proposed law</u> creates the GUMBO Fund to provide grants to help fund broadband access in rural and disadvantaged areas pursuant to the provisions of the Granting Unserved Municipalities Broadband Opportunities program.

The creation of the GUMBO Fund and transfer of monies into the fund is effective if and when House Bill No. 648 of this 2021 R.S. is enacted and becomes effective.

The remaining provisions of the bill are effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

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### Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

- The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Appropriations</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:
- 1. Create the Louisiana Rescue Plan Fund, Louisiana Water Infrastructure Fund Granting Unserved Municipalities Broadband Opportunities Fund, Louisiana Loggers Relief Fund, and Louisiana Save Our Screens Fund.
- 2. Require the transfer of monies into the funds.
- 3. Establish programs for the administration of the funds.
