Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary C to Original Senate Bill No. 85

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 5, after "conviction;" insert "to provide certain conditions for prisoners  
3 convicted before November 1, 2017;"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 2, delete lines 4 through 7 and insert the following:

6 "(c) ~~The~~ (i) Except as provided in Item (ii) of this Subparagraph, the  
7 provisions of this Paragraph shall apply only to offenders who commit an offense or  
8 whose probation or parole is revoked on or after November 1, 2017.

9 (ii) The provisions of this Paragraph shall apply to an offender who  
10 committed an offense or whose probation or parole was revoked prior to  
11 November 1, 2017, if all of the following conditions are met:

12 (aa) The offender has not committed more than three disciplinary  
13 offenses, as identified by the Department of Public Safety and Corrections in the  
14 Disciplinary Rules and Procedures for Adult Offenders, during his  
15 incarceration.

16 (bb) The offender has completed a certified treatment and  
17 rehabilitation program, as provided for by R.S. 15:828, that is specifically  
18 related to the offense for which the offender has been incarcerated.

19 (cc) The offender has either:

20 (1) Completed a one hundred hour standardized pre-release orientation  
21 program, as provided for by R.S. 15:827.1.

22 (2) Voluntarily participated in community service work with  
23 charities outside of the correctional facility.

24 (dd)The offender has an excellent performance record in  
25 institutional jobs or work while incarcerated."
