2	To commend Doveal Austin Essex on the occasion of her one hundredth birthday.
3	WHEREAS, Naomi Doveal Austin was born on May 9, 1921, in Ponchatoula,
4	Louisiana, to Johnie Austin and Katie Cousin Austin; she was christened at Tasker's Chapel
5	African Methodist Episcopal Zion Church in Ponchatoula; and
6	WHEREAS, Doveal attended elementary school at Ponchatoula's Rosenwald School;
7	she graduated from Kentwood Tangipahoa Parish Training School and enrolled at the
8	formerly named Louisiana Negro Normal, now known as Grambling State University; she
9	graduated in May 1945 with a bachelor of science degree in education and began her
10	professional career as a teacher in Ponchatoula; she later earned a master's degree at the
11	University of Michigan in Ann Arbor; and
12	WHEREAS, Doveal married Henry Leroy Essex on October 11, 1945; Mrs. Essex
13	moved to Grambling to take a position at Grambling's Demonstration School where she
14	taught until 1953; the Essex family increased with the birth of two daughters, Constant
15	Elizabeth and Sylvia Marie; and
16	WHEREAS, the Essex family moved to Baton Rouge where Doveal worked as an
17	elementary school teacher until she accepted a position at Southern University's College of
18	Education; she worked at Southern University until her retirement, in 1976, after thirty years
19	of dedicated service; and
20	WHEREAS, today, Mrs. Essex is a member of First Presbyterian Church of
21	Scotlandville where she serves as a Sunday School teacher and served as a past president of

1	the Women of the Church; she also volunteers with Red Cross and Meals on Wheels; she is
2	a docent and member of the Louisiana Arts and Science Museum Board and holds
3	membership in the Gamma Eta Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., the
4	Baton Rouge Chapter of The Links, Inc., and many other civic organizations; and
5	WHEREAS, Mrs. Essex is a recipient of the Silver Magnolia Award from the
6	Women's Council of Greater Baton Rouge for her community service; and
7	WHEREAS, Doveal Austin Essex is a true light in the Baton Rouge community; she
8	has selflessly given to others throughout the course of her inspiring life, and she is most
9	deserving of recognition.
10	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
11	Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend Doveal Austin Essex on the occasion of her
12	one hundredth birthday; does hereby recognize Mrs. Essex's devotion to her community; and
