2	To enact R.S. 40:1730.23(J), relative to enforcement of the state uniform construction code;
3	to provide for inspections of commercial and residential structures; to prohibit
4	remote virtual inspections of such structures; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 40:1730.23(J) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§1730.23. Enforcement of building codes by municipalities and parishes
8	* * *
9	J. A properly registered certified building inspector shall conduct all
10	inspections of any commercial or residential structure and shall be present on site for
11	such inspections.

**Abstract:** Prohibits virtual inspections of commercial or residential structures to enforce the state uniform construction code.

Present law regulates the enforcement of the state uniform construction code.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and requires inspections to be conducted by a registered certified building inspector and requires the inspector to be on site for such inspections.
