
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Insurance to Engrossed Senate Bill No. 119
by Senator Tarver

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, at the end of line 1, insert "**Such examinations shall be in accordance with**
3 **recommendations by National Comprehensive Cancer Network guidelines or the**
4 **American Society of Breast Surgeons Position Statement on Screening Mammography**
5 **no later than the following policy or plan year following changes in the**
6 **recommendations.**"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 2

8 On page 2, line 5, after "**by any**" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 6 and 7 in
9 their entirety and insert "**validated model published in peer reviewed medical literature.**"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 3

11 On page 2, delete line 11 in its entirety and insert the following:

12 **"(i) Consideration given to supplemental imaging (breast ultrasound**
13 **initial preferred modality, followed by MRI if inconclusive), if recommended by**
14 **her"**

15 AMENDMENT NO. 4

16 On page 2, after line 16, insert the following:

17 **"(iii) Any coverage provided pursuant to this Subsection may be subject**
18 **to the health coverage plan's utilization review using guidelines published in**
19 **peer reviewed medical literature consistent with this Section."**

20 AMENDMENT NO. 5

21 On page 2, line 19, after "Section 2." delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 20 and
22 21 in their entirety and insert "This Act shall apply to any new policy, contract, program, or
23 health coverage plan issued on and after January 1, 2022. Any policy, contract, or health
24 coverage plan in effect prior to January 1, 2022, shall convert to conform to the provisions
25 of this Act on or before the renewal date, but no later than January 1, 2023."
