Abstract: Exempts payments made pursuant to a military survivor benefit plan from state income tax.

<u>Proposed law</u> exempts payments made pursuant to a military survivor benefit plan authorized pursuant to <u>federal law</u> to the surviving spouse or other named beneficiary of the plan from state income tax.

Proposed law applies to tax periods beginning on or after Jan. 1, 2021.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

- 1. Add provisions specifying that <u>proposed law</u> applies to a plan authorized pursuant to <u>federal law</u> (10 U.S.C. 1447 through 1455).
- 2. Add provisions providing that <u>proposed law</u> applies to tax periods beginning on or after Jan. 1, 2021.
- 3. Make technical changes.
