ABORTION

EG GF EX See Note

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Establishes requirements concerning reports of abortions performed or induced

Proposed law requires the Louisiana Department of Health to provide general copies of all abortion reports to the Department of Children and Family Services in which a minor pregnant woman under the age of 13 received an abortion. Proposed law requires a hospital licensed by LDH to submit a report to the department on patients who present for treatment in the emergency department as a result of complications after an abortion. Proposed law requires LDH, in consultation with the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners, to jointly promulgate rules regarding the electronic coding, reporting, and tracking of complications after any abortion that is treated at a hospital. Proposed law requires the report to include the general nature of the abortion procedure, the resulting complication, and the identity of the facility in which the original abortion was performed.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

The Office of Public Health currently collects reports of induced termination of pregnancy and publishes reports based on certain data contained in those reports. This measure requires certain additional data to be collected and added to these reports. The collection and reporting of this additional data is not anticipated to result in any additional expenditures of LDH. The LSBME indicates a projected increase in IT system and maintenance costs (\$137,000 in FY 22) to the extent the board is responsible for the collection and reporting of the specific data required under this measure, however the costs will be mitigated if the board serves only in an advisory role to LDH.
