3 "R.S. 17:24.4(E)(7), 17:274.1(E), and 351.1(F),"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, at the end of line 4, insert "to prohibit the adoption of certain state content
6 standards by the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education; to prohibit the
7 recommendation of certain curricula, textbooks, and instructional materials by the State
8 Board of Elementary and Secondary Education and the state Department of Education; to
9 provide relative to requests for proposals and contracts for curricula, textbooks, and
10 instructional materials;"

12 On page 1, line 7, after "reenacted and" delete the remainder of the line and insert "R.S.
